If you have staff who need to undertake a **Cert Ed** or **PGCE** within the 2019-20 academic year your organisation could be eligible to receive a bursary worth up to £4000 to contribute towards the cost of the teacher training.

Eligible candidates must:

1. Be completing a Cert Ed or PGCE within the academic year 2019-20
2. Must be in relation to one of the SELEP priority sector areas (see table below)
3. Have their college/ITP agreement to provide £1500 match funding
4. Be aware the funding limit is £4000 per person
